5 hanks BERROCO ULTRA ALPACA (100 grs), #6201 Winter White, 2 hanks each #6278 Stone Washed Mix, #62169 Twinkle Mix and #6243 Navy, 1 hank each # #62168 Candy Floss Mix, #62178 Grapefruit Mix, #62179 Melon Mix, #6268 Candied Yam Mix, #62180 Grove Mix, #62176 Pink Berry Mix and #62174 Dungaree Mix Straight knitting needles, size 8 (5.00 mm) OR SIZE TO OBTAIN **GAUGE** 4 st holders Crochet hook, size H (5.00mm)

20 sts and 32 rows = 4" in Garter St TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

NOTE

Each square is worked in one piece, then the squares are joined by crocheting them together. Sample blanket has five each of the four block designs, but you could choose any configuration of the blocks that you like! For more information on calculating yarn quantity for other block configurations, see our blog post.



BLOCK 1 by Emily Nora O'Neil



NOTE

This square is worked all in one piece with no seaming. After completing the center section, you will be working back and forth, first on the side sections, then on the end sections.

SQUARE

Center: With #62168, cast on 20 sts. Knit 8 rows. Change to #6201 and k44 rows. Change back to #62168 and knit 8 rows, sl sts to a holder.

Start Sides: With RS facing, using #6201, working along one side edge of center, pick up and k3 sts over #62168 section, 22 sts over #6201 section, then 3 sts over second #62168 section – 28 sts. Knit 7 rows. SI sts to holder. With RS facing, working along second side edge of center, work second side same as first. **Start Ends:** With RS facing, using #62168, working along cast-on edge of Center, pick up and k3 sts over #6201 section, 20 sts over #62168 section, then 3 sts over #6201 section – 26 sts. Knit 7 rows. SI sts to holder. With RS facing, using #62168, working across the other end of center, pick up and k3 sts over #6201 section, k20 sts from holder, then pick up and k3 sts over the other #6201 section – 26 sts. Knit 7 rows. SI sts to holder.

Continue Sides: With RS facing, using #6201, working along side edge of center, pick up and k4 sts over #62168 section, k28 sts from holder, then pick up and k4 sts over second #62168 section – 36 sts. Knit 7 rows. SI sts to holder. With RS facing, work second side same as first.


Continue Ends: With RS facing, using #6278 and working along cast-on edge of center, pick up and k4 sts over #6201 section, k26 sts from holder, then pick up and k4 sts over second #6201 section – 34 sts.

Knit 3 rows. SI sts to holder. With RS facing, using #62178 and working along the other end of center, work same as first end.

Continue Sides: With RS facing, using #62179 and working along one side edge of center, pick up and k2 sts over #6278 section, k36 sts from holder, then pick up and k2 sts over #62178 section – 40 sts. Knit 3 rows. Change to #6201 and k10 rows. Bind off. With RS facing, using #6268 and working along the other side edge of center, pick up and k2 sts over #62178 section, k36 sts from holder, then pick up and k2 sts over #6278 section. Knit 3 rows. Change to #6201 and k10 rows. Bind off. Sides are now completed. Continue Ends: With RS facing, using #6201, working along cast-on edge of center, pick up and k5 sts over #6201 section, 2 sts over #62179 section, k34 sts from holder, pick up and k2 sts over #6268 section, then 5 sts over #6201 section – 48 sts. Knit 9 rows. Bind off. With RS facing, using #6201 and working along the other end of center, pick up and k5 sts over #6201 section, 2 sts over #6268 section, k34 sts from holder, pick up and k2 sts over #62179

section, then 5 sts over #6201 section – 48 sts. Knit 9

rows. Bind off. Square is now completed.



BLOCK 2 by Amy Christoffers



NOTE

This square is made in one piece with no seaming and is worked all in Garter St. After working Section 1, you will be turning work and picking up sts on all sides for the remaining sections.

SQUARE

Section 1: With #6268, cast on 20 sts. Knit 9 rows (5 ridges). Change to #62178 and knit 10 rows. Change to #62180 and knit 10 rows. Bind off and mark bindoff as RS of work.

Section 2: Turn work 90 degrees to the left. With RS facing, using #6201, pick up and k17 sts along right side edge of Section 1. Knit 5 rows (3 ridges), then bind off on RS.


Section 3: Turn work 180 degrees. With RS facing, using #62168, pick up and k17 sts along left side edge of Section 1. Knit 3 rows. Change to #62179 and knit 18 rows. Change to #62180 and knit 6 rows. Change to #6201 and knit 6 rows. Bind off on RS.

Section 4: Turn work 90 degrees to the right. With RS facing, using #6278, pick up and k42 sts along side edge of Section 3, cast-on edge of Section 1, and side edge of Section 2. Knit 3 rows. Change to #62168 and knit 4 rows. Change to #62180 and knit 10 rows. Change to #6268 and knit 18 rows. Change to #6201 and knit 4 rows. Change to #62179 and knit 10 rows. Bind off on RS.

Section 5: Turn work 90 degrees to the right. With RS facing, using #62178, pick up and k42 sts along bound-off edge of Section 3 and side edge of Section 4. Knit 13 rows. Bind off on RS.

Section 6: Turn work 90 degrees to the left. With RS facing, using #6278, pick up and k50 sts along side edge of Section 2, bound-off edge of Section 1, side

edge of Section 3 and side edge of Section 5. Knit 9 rows. Bind off on RS.



BLOCK 3 by Ashley Palumbo



NOTE

This square is made in one piece with no seaming and is worked all in Garter St. After working Section 1, you will be turning work and picking up sts on all sides for the remaining sections.

SQUARE

Section 1: With #62179, cast on 8 sts. Knit 14 rows, change to #6201 and knit 2 rows. Change to #62178 and knit 6 rows, end on WS. Bind off.

Section 2: Turn piece 90 degrees to the right. With RS facing, using #6201, pick up and k4 sts along #62178 rows, 2 sts along #6201 rows, then 7 sts along #62179 rows – 13 sts. Knit 1 row. Change to #62168 and knit 6 rows, end on WS. Bind off.

Section 3: Turn piece 90 degrees to the right again.

With RS facing, using #6201, pick up and k4 sts along #62168 rows, 1 st along #6201 rows, then 9 sts along #62179 rows – 14 sts. Knit 3 rows. Change to #62178 and knit 6 rows, end on WS. Bind off.

Section 4: Turn piece 90 degrees to the right again. With RS facing, using #6201, pick up and k3 sts along #62178 rows, 2 sts along #6201 rows, 9 sts along #62179 rows, 2 sts along #6201 rows, then 3 sts along #62178 rows – 19 sts. Knit 3 rows. Change to #62168 and knit 6 rows, end on WS. Bind off.

Section 5: Turn piece 90 degrees to the right again. With RS facing, using #6201, pick up and k4 sts along #62168 rows, 2 sts along #6201 rows, 8 sts along #62178 rows, 2 sts along #6201 rows, then 4 sts along #62168 rows – 20 sts. Knit 3 rows. Change to #62176 and knit 6 rows, end on WS. Bind off.

Section 6: Turn piece 90 degrees to the left. With RS facing, using #6201, pick up and k21 sts along #62168 rows, 2 sts along #6201 rows, then 4 sts along #62176 rows – 27 sts. Knit 3 rows. Change to #62176 and knit 6 rows, end on WS. Bind off.

Section 7: Turn piece 90 degrees to the right. With RS facing, using #6201, pick up and k4 sts along #62176 rows, 2 sts along #6201 rows, then 20 sts along #62176 rows – 26 sts. Knit 3 rows. Change to #6243 and knit 6 rows, end on WS. Bind off.

Section 8: Turn piece 90 degrees to the left. With RS facing, using #6201, pick up and k26 sts along #62176 rows, 2 sts along #6201 rows, then 4 sts along #6243 rows – 32 sts. Knit 3 rows. Change to #6243 and knit 6 rows, end on WS. Bind off.

Section 9: Turn piece 90 degree to the right. With RS facing, using #6201, pick up and k4 sts along #6243 rows, 2 sts along #6201 rows, then 26 sts along #6243 rows – 32 sts. Knit 3 rows. Change to #6243 and knit 6 rows, end on WS. Bind off.

Section 10: With RS facing, using #6201, pick up and k32 sts along bound-off edge of Section 9. Knit 3 rows. Change to #6243 and knit 6 rows, end on WS. Bind off.

Section 11: Turn piece 90 degrees to the right. With RS facing, using #6201, pick up and k4 sts along #6243 rows, 2 sts along #6201 rows, 4 sts along #6243 rows, 2 sts along #6201 rows, 4 sts along #6243F rows, 2 sts along #6201 rows, 4 sts along #62176 rows, 2 sts along #6201 rows, 15 sts along #62168 rows, 2 sts along #6201 rows, then 4 sts along #62178

rows – 45 sts. Knit 3 rows. Change to #62169 and knit 6 rows, end on WS.


Section 12: With RS facing, using #6201, pick up and k45 sts along bound-off edge of Section 11. Knit 3 rows. Change to #62169 and knit 6 rows, end on WS. Bind off.

Edging: First Side: With RS facing, using #6201, pick up and k45 sts along bound-off edge of Section 12. Knit 3 rows, end on WS. Bind off.

Second Side: Turn piece 90 degrees to the right. With RS facing, using #6201, pick up and k 2 sts along end of first side, 4 sts along #6243 rows, 2 sts along #6201 rows, 4 sts along #6243 rows, 2 sts along #6201 rows, 15 sts along #62178 sts, 2 sts along #6201 rows, 4 sts along #62168 rows, 2 sts along #6201 rows, 4 sts along #62176 rows, 2 sts along #6201 rows, then 4 sts along #6243 rows – 47 sts. Knit 3 rows, end on WS. Bind off.

Third Side: Turn piece 90 degrees to the right. With RS facing, using #6201, pick up and k2 sts along end of second side, 33 sts along #6243 sts, 2 sts along #6201 rows, 4 sts along #6243 rows, 2 sts along #6201 rows, then 4 sts along #6243 rows – 47 sts. Knit 3 rows, end on WS. Bind off.

Fourth Side: Turn piece 90 degrees to the right. With RS facing, using #6201, pick up and k2 sts along end of third side, 33 sts along #6243 sts, 2 sts along #6201 rows, 4 sts along #62169 rows, 2 sts along #6201 rows, 4 sts along #62169 rows, then 2 sts along beg of first side – 49 sts. Knit 3 rows. Bind off.



BLOCK 4 by Alison Green



NOTE

This square is made in one piece with no seaming and is worked all in Garter St. After working Section 1, you will be turning work and picking up sts on all sides for the remaining sections.

SQUARE

Section 1: With #6243, cast on 12 sts. Knit 7 rows (4 ridges). Change to #6278 and knit 8 rows. Change to #62169 and knit 8 rows. Bind off and mark bind-off as RS of work.

Section 2: Turn work 90 degrees to the right. With RS facing, using #62174, pick up and knit 12 sts along left side edge of Section 1. Knit 7 rows (4 ridges), then bind off on RS.

Section 3: Turn work 90 degrees to the right. With RS facing, using #62176, pick up and k16 sts along side edge 2 and cast on of Section 1. Knit 3 rows (2 ridges). Change to #6243 and knit 8 rows. Change to #6278 and knit 8 rows. Change to #62174 and knit 8 rows. Bind off on RS.

Section 4: Turn work 90 degrees to the right. With RS facing, using #6278, pick up and k26 sts along side edges of Sections 3 and 1. Knit 11 rows (6 ridges). Change to #62176 and knit 4 rows. Bind off on RS.

Section 5: Turn work 180 degrees. With RS facing, using #6243, pick up and k26 sts along bound-off edge of Section 2 and side edge of Section 3. Knit 3 rows. Change to #6201 and knit 2 rows. Change to C and knit 8 rows. Bind off on RS.


Section 6: Turn work 90 degrees to the right. With RS facing, using #6201, pick up and k31 sts along side edge of Section 5, bound-off edge of Section 3 and side edge of Section 4. Knit 3 rows. Change to #62174 and knit 8 rows. Change to #62169 and knit 8

rows. Bind off on RS.

Section 7: Turn work 180 degrees. With RS facing, using #6243, pick up and k31 sts along side edge of Section 4, bound-off edge of Section 1, side edge of Section 2 and side edge of Section 5. Knit 3 rows. Change to #62169 and knit 12 rows. Change to #62174 and knit 8 rows. Bind off on RS.

Section 8: Turn work 90 degrees to the right. With RS facing, using #62176, pick up and k48 sts along side edge of Section 7, bound-off edge of Section 5 and side edge of Section 6. Knit 3 rows. Change to #6278 and knit 8 rows. Change to #6243 and knit 4 rows. Bind off on RS.

Section 9: Turn work 180 degrees. With RS facing, using #6243, pick up and k48 sts along side edge of Section 6, bound-off edge of Section 4 and side edge of Section 6. Knit 3 rows. Change to #6201 and knit 4 rows. Change to #6278 and knit 10 rows. Bind off on RS.



FINISHING


Weave in all ends and block squares as desired. Use diagram as a guide to block placement and direction, or choose your own configuration. With #6201 and crochet hook, join blocks into strips as follows:

Align two blocks, with RS facing out. * Insert hook into edge of left block, then into edge of right block, and pull up a loop. Yo hook and pull through loop.

Rep from *.

Join the strips using the same method, then work 1 row of sc around entire blanket. Weave in any remaining ends.

ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

Knit

beg: beginning **CC:** contrasting color

cdd (centered double decrease): Slip 2 together,

knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over.

cn: cable needlecont: continuedec: decrease

dpn: double pointed needles

est: establishedinc: increaseK: knit

k tbl: knit through the back loop(s)k2tog: Knit 2 stitches togetherk3tog: Knit 3 stitches together

LH: left hand **MC:** main color

M1: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1L: Work as for M1.

M1p: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1pL: Work as for M1p.

M1pR: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

M1R: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

p: purl

p tbl: purl through the back loop(s)

pat(s): pattern(s)
pm: place marker

psso: pass slip stitch over knit stitch **p2tog:** purl 2 stitches together

p2sso: pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch

p3tog: purl 3 stitches together

rem: remaining rep: repeat RH: right hand rnd(s): round(s) RS: right side sl: slip

sm: slip marker

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

SSP: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.

st(s): stitch(es)

TBL: through back loop(s)

tog: together **WS:** wrong side

wyib: with yarn in backwyif: with yarn in front

yo: yarn over

end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side

row

end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side

row

STOCKINETTE ST (St st): Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

Reverse St st (Rev St st): Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

GARTER ST: Knit EVERY row when working on straight needles. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working on a circular needle.

dc: double crochet **hdc:** half double crochet

sc: single crochet
sl st: slip stitch
sp: space
tr: treble
