materials

BERROCO ULTRA ALPACA FINE (100

grs): 1 hank #1275 Pea Soup Mix 29" (or longer) circular knitting needle, size 5 (3.75 mm) or size to obtain gauge

gauge

32 sts and 40 rows = 4" in Pat St To save time, take time to check gauge

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SHAWL

Cast on 6 sts.

Row 1 (WS): Using Cable Cast-On, cast on 4 sts, k1, * sl 2 wyif, bring yarn to the back, sl the same 2 sts back to LH needle and knit them, rep from * to last st, end k1.

Row 2 (RS): Using Cable Cast-On, cast on 4 sts, knit across.

Rep these 2 rows 70 times more, end with Row 2 - 574 sts.

Next Row (WS): K1, * sl 2 wyif, bring yarn to the back, sl the same 2 sts back to LH needle and knit them, rep from * to last st, end k1.

Next Row: Knit.

Rep last 2 rows once more.

Cut yarn, leaving a very long tail, approximately 5 yards.

Sewn Bind-Off: Thread tail into tapestry needle. * With yarn threaded on tapestry needle, bring the tapestry needle and yarn through the first 2 sts on needle (working from right to left). Bring the tapestry needle back through the first st on the needle (working from left to right), then drop the st off the needle. Rep from * until all sts have been bound off.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends and block as desired.
