BERROCO MYKONOS (50 grs): 4 (4, 5, 5, 6, 7) hanks #8518 Calliope

needles and notions

Straight needles, size 6 (4.00 mm) or size to obtain gauge 2 Stitch markers 1 Stitch holder

gauge

21 sts and 28 rows = 4" in St st To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge

EYELET PATTERN

(Worked over 4 sts)

Row 1 (RS): K2tog, [yo] twice, SSK

Row 2: P2, k1, p1

Rep these 2 rows for Eyelet Pattern.

BACK

Cast on 68 (78, 92, 100, 112, 122) sts. Purl 1 row, knit 1 row, purl 1 row, end on WS.

Inc Row (RS): K3, [yo] twice, k to last 3 sts, [yo] twice, k3 – 4 sts inc'd.

Following Row (WS): P3, knit the first yo, purl the second yo, purl to last 5 sts, purl the first yo, knit the second yo, p3. Rep the last 2 rows 5 times more – 92 (102, 116, 124, 136, 146) sts. Mark beginning and end of last row. Work even in St st until piece measures 5 (5, 5½, 5½, 6, 6)" from beg, end on WS.

Dec Row (RS): K3, k2tog, knit to last 5 sts, SSK, k3 – 2 sts dec'd. Rep Dec Row every 4th row 6 times more – 78 (88, 102, 110, 122, 132) sts. Work even until piece measures 12½ (12½, 13, 13, 13½, 13½)" from beginning, end on WS.

Inc Row (RS): K3, M1L, knit to last 3 sts, M1R, k3 – 2 sts inc'd. Rep this inc every 6th row twice more – 84 (94, 108, 116, 128, 138) sts. Work even until piece measures 16 (16, 16½, 16½, 17, 17)" from beginning, end on WS.

Shape Armholes: Bind off 5 (6, 6, 7, 7, 8) sts at beginning of the next 2 rows – 74 (82, 96, 102, 114, 122) sts.

Dec Row 1 (RS): K3, k3tog, knit to last 6 sts, slip 1, k2tog, psso, k3 – 4 sts dec'd.

Rep Dec Row 1 every RS row 0 (1, 5, 6, 6, 7) times more, end on WS.

Dec Row 2 (RS): K3, k2tog, knit to last 5 sts, SSK, k3 – 2 sts dec'd.

Rep Dec Row 2 every RS row 2 (4, 1, 2, 5, 7) times – 64 (64, 68, 68, 74, 74) sts.







Work even until armholes measure $8\frac{1}{2}$ ($8\frac{1}{2}$, 9, 9, $9\frac{1}{2}$, 10)", end on WS.

Shape Neck: Next Row (RS): K17 (17, 19, 19, 22, 22), slip these sts to holder for right shoulder; bind off center 30 sts, knit to end – 17 (17, 19, 19, 22, 22) sts.

Left Shoulder: Work WS row even. Bind off 6 sts at beginning of next 2 RS rows. Bind off 5 (5, 7, 7, 10, 10) remaining sts for shoulders.

Right Shoulder: Rejoin yarn at neck edge and bind off 6 sts at beginning of next 2 WS rows. Bind off 5 (5, 7, 7, 10, 10) remaining sts for shoulders.

FRONT

Work as for back until piece measures 14½ (14½, 15, 15, 15½, 15½)" from beginning, end on WS. Mark center 4 sts on last row; you will have 40 (45, 52, 56, 62, 67) sts on each side of markers if you have completed all the side increases.

Note: Please read through this entire next section before starting to knit.

Establish Front Detail: Next Row (RS): Knit to first marker, sm, work Row 1 of Eyelet Pattern over 4 sts, sm, knit to end.

Following Row: Purl to first marker, sm, work Row 2 of Eyelet Pattern over 4 sts, sm, purl to end. Rep these 2 rows 8 times more, continuing to inc at side edges as before if necessary. AT THE SAME TIME, when piece measures 16 (16, 16½, 16½, 17, 17)" from beginning, shape armholes as for back. When 18 rows of Front Detail have been completed, end on WS and divide for neck as follows.:

Divide for Neck: Next Row (RS): Continuing to work armhole decs, work to 2 sts before first marker, k2tog, remove marker, k2, slip remaining sts to holder for right side.

Left Side: Work WS row even.


Shape Neck: Neck Dec Row (RS): Continuing to work armhole decs, work to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2 - 1 st dec'd at neck. Continuing to work armhole decs until they are complete, rep Neck Dec Row every RS row 25 times more – 5 (5, 7, 7, 10, 10) sts. Work even until armhole measures 9 (9, $9\frac{1}{2}$, $9\frac{1}{2}$, 10, $10\frac{1}{2}$)", end on WS. Bind off.

Right Side: With WS facing, sl sts from holder to straight needle. Join yarn and, continuing to work armhole decs, work 1 WS row.

Shape Neck: Neck Dec Row (RS): K2, remove marker, SSK, work to end, continuing to work armhole decs – 1 st dec'd at neck. Still continuing to work armhole decs, rep Neck Dec Row every RS row 25 times more – 5 (5, 7, 7, 10, 10) sts. Work even until armhole measures 9 (9, 9½, 9½, 10, 10½)", end on WS. Bind off.

FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams. Sew side seams from underarms to markers.



STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

beg: beginning **CC:** contrasting color

CDD: Centered Double Decrease—Slip 2 together (as if to k2tog), knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches

cn: cable needle dec: decrease

dpn(s): double pointed needle(s)

end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong

Side row.

end on RS: end having just completed a Right

Side row

Garter St: Knit EVERY row when working back and forth in rows. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when

working in the round. inc: increase

k: knit

k tbl: knit through the back loop(s) **k2tog:** knit 2 stitches together **k3tog:** knit 3 stitches together

kfb: knit in the front and back of the next st

LH: left hand

LLI: Left Lifted Increase—Insert LH needle into the purl bump one row below the st just worked on the RH needle and knit into this st (1 st inc'd)

M1: Make 1—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1L: Make 1 Left—Work as for M1.

M1p: Make 1 purl—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1pL: Make 1 purl Left—Work as for M1p. M1pR: Make 1 purl Right—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

M1R: Make 1 Right—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

MC: main color

p: purl

p tbl: purl through the back loop(s) **p2tog:** purl 2 stitches together

p3tog: purl 3 stitches together

pat(s): pattern(s) pm: place marker

psso: pass slipped stitch over knit stitch

rep: repeat

Rev St st: Reverse Stockinette Stitch—Purl 1 row. knit 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round.

RH: right hand

RLI: Right Lifted Increase—Insert RH needle into the purl bump of the next st on the LH needle and knit into this st (1 st inc'd)

rnd(s): round(s) **RS:** right side

sl: slip

sm: slip marker

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

SSP: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.

SSSK: Slip 3 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 3 stitches and knit 3 together.

st(s): stitch(es)

St st: Stockinette Stitch—Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round.

tbl: through back loop(s)

w&t: wrap and turn, a method of concealing a hole created in short row shaping. On RS rows: With yarn held in front, slip next stitch purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the back. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle. Turn your work. On WS Rows: With yarn held in back, slip next stitch purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the front. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle. Turn your work. Unless otherwise indicated, each time you come to a wrapped stitch when working subsequent rows, slip the wrap back over stitch and onto needle, then work the wrap together with its accompanying stitch.

WS: wrong side

wyib: with yarn in back wyif: with yarn in front

yo: yarn over

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
