**skill level:** Intermediate One size

#### finished measurements

Small Basket—Approximately 8" across base x 6" deep Large Basket—Approximately 10" across base x 2½" deep

#### yarn

BERROCO SUEDE (50 grs): 1 ball each #3714 Hopalong Cassidy (CC1) and #3729 Zorro (CC2) for each basket

#### needles and notions

Crochet hook, size 4.50 mm (7) or size to obtain gauge Removable stitch marker or safety pin

#### gauge

21 sts and 18 rnds = 4" in sc worked over pattern
To save time and ensure accurate fit, take time to check gauge

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**NOTE:** We recommend using yarns called for in our instructions. Every effort has been made to ensure that directions contained in this book are accurate and complete, however errors do occur. #### SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

**Dec 1:** Pull up a loop in each of the next 2 sc, yo and pull through all loops on hook—1 sc dec'd.



### SMALL BASKET

**Base:** With crochet hook, using CC1, ch 7. Join with a slip stitch to form a ring.

**Rnd 1:** Work 15 sc into ring, join with a sl st in first sc—15 sc. Mark beginning of round with marker or safety pin and move marker up as you work.

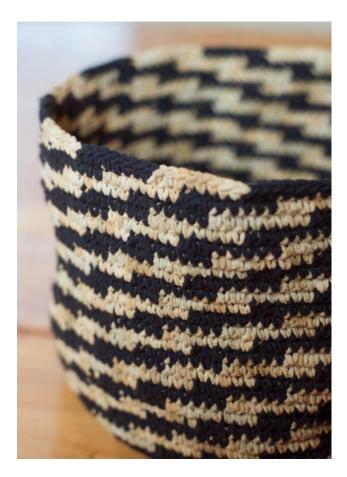
**Rnd 2:** With CC1, ch 1, work 2 sc in each sc around, join with a slip stitch in beginning ch-1—30 sc. Join CC2.

**Rnd 3:** With CC2, ch 1, sc in each sc around, join with a slip stitch in beginning ch-1.

**Rnd 4:** With CC1, ch 1, \* sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, rep from \* around, join with a slip stitch in beginning ch-1—45 sc.

**Rnd 5:** With CC2, ch 1, sc in each sc around, join with a slip stitch in beginning ch-1.

**Rnd 6:** With CC1, ch 1, \* sc in each of the next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, rep from \* around, join with a slip stitch in beginning ch-1—60 sc.



**Rnd 7:** With CC2, ch 1, sc in each sc around, join with a slip stitch in beginning ch-1.

Continue to inc 15 sc CC1 round, (having 1 more sc between incs and alternating rounds of CC1 and CC2) 5 times more, end with a CC1 round - 135 sc.

**Next Rnd:** With CC2, \* sc in 43 sc, dec 1 over the next 2 sc, rep from \* once more, sc to the last 2 sc, dec 1 over the last 2 sc—132 sc.

**Note:** Remove marker at this point and work in a spiral around. When working Pattern Stitch, as you work with one color, hold the other color along top of work and work scs over the strand carried color. When you get to the last sc of an 8-sc group, to change colors, work the last sc until there are 2 loops on hook, then pull carried color through those loops.

**Pattern Stitch:** \* With CC1, sc in each of the next 8 sc, with CC2, sc in each of the next 8 sc, rep from \* until sides of basket measure 6" or desired depth. Fasten off.

#### **FINISHING**

Weave in all ends and block as desired.



#### LARGE BASKET

**Base:** Work as for small basket until Rnd 7 has been completed—60 sc.

Continue to inc 15 sc every CC1 round, (having 1 more sc between incs and alternating CC2 and CC1) 8 times more—180 sc.

**Note:** Remove marker at this point and work in a spiral around. When working Pattern Stitch, as you work with one color, hold the other color along top of work and work scs over the strand carried color. When you get to the last sc of an 8-sc group, to change colors, work the last sc until there are 2 loops of yarn on hook, then pull carried color through those loops.

**Pattern Stitch:** \* With CC1, sc in each of the next 8 sc, with CC2, sc in each of the next 8 sc, rep from \* until sides of basket measure 2½" or desired depth. Fasten off.

#### **FINISHING**

Weave in all ends and block as desired.



#### STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

beg: beginning **CC:** contrasting color

cont: continue **ch:** chain dec: decrease dc: double crochet dtr: double treble crochet

est: established

hdc: half double crochet

inc: increase MC: main color pat(s): pattern(s) pm: place marker rep: repeat rnd(s): round(s) RS: right side sc: single crochet sl st: slip stitch

**sliding loop:** Form a loop of yarn around your fingers, with the end attached to the ball on the right and the tail on the left. Insert hook into the loop under both pieces of yarn and draw up a loop onto hook. (This does not count as your first stitch.) Work first row into the original loop. Pull up the yarn tail after your first row is complete to close the loop.

sp: space st(s): stitch(es) tog: together tr: treble WS: wrong side yo: yarn over

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
