skill level: Intermediate

finished measurements

Approximately 16" around leg and foot x 24" long

yarn

[BERROCO MACRO](#) (250 grs):

For Merry (Striped Stocking): 1 hank each #6755 Bramble (C1), #6735 Arctic Poppy (C2), and #6701 Snowshoe Hare (C3)

For Holly (Cabled Stocking): 2 hanks #6701 Snowshoe Hare (C3) and small amount #6755 Bramble (C1), and #6735 Arctic Poppy (C2)

For Jolly (Snowman Stocking): 1 hank each #6755 Bramble (C1), #6735 Arctic Poppy (C2) and #6701 Snowshoe Hare (C3), small amount #6770 Dall Sheep (C4), and a few yards black worsted-weight yarn for embroidery

needles and notions

For All: Two 24" circular needles, size 17 (12.75 mm) or size to obtain gauge

Crochet hook, size 10.00 mm (N-15)

Stitch markers

Tapestry needle

2½" pom-pom maker

For Holly (Cable Stocking): Cable needle (cn)

1 piece of cardboard approximately 8" long

For Jolly (Snowman Stocking): Five ½" black ball buttons with shank

2 carrot buttons (from JOANN Fabric & Craft) or two 2½" orange buttons

gauge

9 sts and 12 rows = 4" in St st

To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.

NOTE

All stockings are worked in the round on 2 circular needles from the top down. When changing from one needle to the other, make sure that you pick up the opposite end of the needle holding the sts you will be working. If you pick up the end of the other needle, you will wind up with all the sts on one needle and will have to divide them onto 2 needles again. It is sometimes helpful to use 2 different-colored needles or to mark both ends of one needle with nail polish or a permanent marker.

On Merry (Striped Stocking), colors may be carried on WS of work when not in use. On Jolly (Snowman Stocking), do not carry yarn across more than 2 stitches without twisting colors together to prevent long floats.



1 MERRY

With C1, cast on 32 sts. Divide stitches onto 2 circular needles (16 sts on each needle), place marker, then join for working in the round. [Purl 1 round, knit 1 round] twice. Change to C2 and knit 9 rounds. Change to C3 and knit 2 rounds. Join C1 and knit 2 rounds. Repeat the last 4 rounds twice more, then knit 2 rounds with C3. Change to C2 and knit 6 rounds. Join C1 and knit 3 rounds. Change to C2 and knit 4 rounds.

Note: You will be working back and forth in rows over Heel Flap with C1.

Shape Heel Flap: Row 1 (RS): With C1, using back needle, sl 1 wyib, k15, turn, leaving 16 sts on front needle unworked.

Row 2 (WS): Sl 1 wyif, p15, turn. Rep the last 2 rows 4 times more (10 rows total), end on WS.

Turn Heel: Short Rows: Row 1 (RS): Sl 1 wyib, k8, k2tog, k1, turn—15 sts.

Row 2 (WS): Sl 1 wyif, p3, p2tog, p1, turn—14 sts.

Row 3 (RS): Sl 1 wyib, k4, k2tog, k1, turn—13 sts.

Row 4 (WS): Sl 1 wyif, p5, p2tog, p1, turn—12 sts.

Row 5 (RS): Sl 1 wyib, k6, k2tog, k1, turn—11 sts.

Row 6 (WS): Sl 1 wyif, p7, p2tog, p1, turn—10 sts. Break off yarn.

Gusset: With RS facing, join C3 in beginning of the first row of heel flap, with back needle and C3, pick up and knit 7 sts along right side edge of heel flap, k10 sts from back needle, pick up and knit 7 sts along left side edge of heel flap; with front needle, using C3, k16, place marker for new beginning of round—40 sts.

Note: You will now be working in the round again using both needles and C3.

Knit 1 round.

Dec Rnd: With back needle, k1, SSK, knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1; with front needle, k16—38 sts (2 sts dec'd on back needle). Knit 1 round. Rep the last 2 rounds 3 times more—32 sts (16 sts on each needle).

Foot: Change to C2 and knit 2 rounds. Join C1 and knit 2 rounds. With C2, knit 2 rounds. With C3, knit 2 rounds. With C2, knit 2 rounds. With C3, knit 2 rounds. Change to C1.

Shape Toe: Knit 1 round.

Dec Rnd: [K1, SSK, knit to the last 3 sts on needle, k2tog, k1] twice—4 sts dec'd (2 sts on each needle). Rep the last 2 rounds 4 times more—12 sts (6 sts on each needle). Break off yarn, leaving an 18" long end. Thread end into tapestry needle and graft stitches together using Kitchener Stitch.

FINISHING

Hanging Loop: With crochet hook, join C1 at beginning of first round at top of stocking. Make a chain 3" long (or desired length), join with a slip stitch to top of stocking. Fasten off. Weave in all ends. With C1, make a 2½" pompom and sew to top of stocking below hanging loop.



2 HOLLY

CABLE PATTERN

Worked over 12 sts; follow written instructions below or work from chart.

Rnds 1 and 2: P2, k8, p2.

Rnd 3: P2, sl 2 sts to cn and hold in BACK, k2, k2 from cn, sl 2 sts to cn and hold in FRONT, k2, k2 from cn, p2.

Rnds 4, 5, and 6: P2, k8, p2.

Rnd 7: P2, sl 2 sts to cn and hold in BACK, k2, p2 from cn, sl 2 sts to cn and hold in FRONT, p2, k2 from cn, p2.

Rnds 8–14: P2, k2, p4, k2, p2.

Rnd 15: P2, sl 2 sts to cn and hold in FRONT, k2, k2 from cn, sl 2 sts to cn and hold in BACK, k2, k2 from cn, p2.

Rnd 16: P2, k8, p2.

Rep these 16 sts for Cable Pattern.

STOCKING

With C3, cast on 32 sts. Divide stitches onto 2 needles (16 sts on each needle), place marker and join for working in the round. [Purl 1 round, knit 1 round] twice.

Inc Rnd: * K8, pm, p2, [M1, k1] 4 times, p2, pm, rep from * once more—40 sts (20 sts on each needle).

Establish Cable Chart: Next Rnd: * Knit to first marker, sm, work Rnd 1 of Cable Pattern to next marker, sm, rep from * once more. Work even in pattern as established until all 16 rounds of Cable Pattern have been completed twice (32 rounds total).

Dec Rnd: * Knit to first marker, remove marker, p2, [k2tog] 4 times, p2, remove marker, rep from * once more, leaving beg-of-rnd marker (last marker) in place—32 sts. Fasten off yarn. From here you will be working all stitches in St st. Removing beg-of-rnd marker, reposition stitches so that 8 sts on each side of marker are on back needle and remaining 16 sts are on front needle.

Note: You will be working back and forth over Heel Flap. Rejoin yarn in first stitch on back needle.

Shape Heel Flap: Row 1 (RS): Using back needle, sl 1 wyib, k15, turn, leaving 16 sts on front needle unworked.

Row 2 (WS): Sl 1 wyif, p15, turn. Rep the last 2 rows 4 times more (10 rows total), end on WS.

Turn Heel: Short Rows: Row 1 (RS): Sl 1 wyib, k8, k2tog, k1, turn—15 sts.

Row 2 (WS): Sl 1 wyif, p3, p2tog, p1, turn—14 sts.

Row 3 (RS): Sl 1 wyib, k4, k2tog, k1, turn—13 sts.

Row 4 (WS): Sl 1 wyif, p5, p2tog, p1, turn—12 sts.

Row 5 (RS): Sl 1 wyib, k6, k2tog, k1, turn—11 sts.

Row 6 (WS): Sl 1 wyif, p7, p2tog, p1, turn—10 sts. Break off yarn.

Gusset: With RS facing, join C3 in beginning of the first row of heel flap. With back needle, pick up and knit 7 sts along right side edge of heel flap, k10 sts from back needle, pick up and knit 7 sts along left side edge of heel flap; with front needle, k16, place marker for new beginning of round—40 sts.

Note: You will now be working in the round again using both needles.

Knit 1 round.

Dec Rnd: With back needle, k1, SSK, knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1; with front needle, k16—38 sts (2 sts dec'd on back needle). Knit 1 round. Rep the last 2 rounds 3 times more—32 sts (16 sts on each needle).

Foot: Knit 12 rounds even.

Shape Toe: Knit 1 round.

Dec Rnd: [K1, SSK, knit to the last 3 sts on needle, k2tog, k1] twice—4 sts dec'd (2 sts on each needle). Rep the last 2 rounds 4 times more—12 sts (6 sts on each needle). Break off yarn, leaving an 18" long end. Thread end into tapestry needle and weave stitches together using Kitchener Stitch.

FINISHING

Hanging Loop: With crochet hook, join C3 at beginning of first round at top of stocking. Make a chain 3" long (or desired length), join with a slip stitch to top of stocking. Fasten off. Weave in all ends.

Tassel: Cut two 18" long strands of C1. Wind 1 strand each of C2 and C3 held together multiple times around an 8" long piece of cardboard. Using 18" long strand of C1, tie all strands together at one edge of cardboard. Cut yarn along the opposite edge, freeing strands from cardboard. Wrap second 18" long strand of C1 multiple times around all strands of tassel approximately 1" down from tie. Fasten ends together and draw into center of tassel. Trim ends to even off and sew tassel to top of stocking below hanging loop.

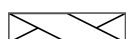

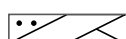

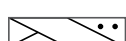
sl 2 to cn and hold to BACK, k2, k2 from cn

sl 2 to cn and hold to BACK, k2, p2 from cn

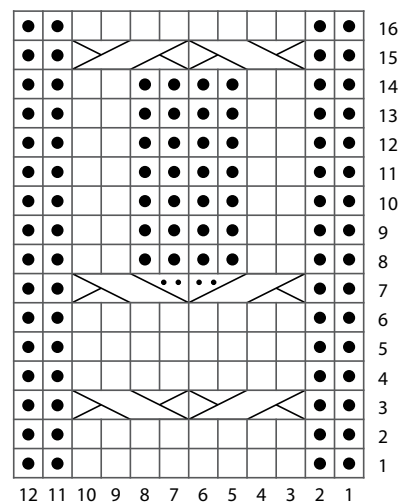


sl 2 to cn and hold to FRONT, p2, k2 from cn

Work from right to left on every rnd.

CABLE CHART





3 JOLLY

With C2, cast on 32 sts. Divide stitches onto 2 needles (16 sts on each needle), place marker and join for working in the round. [Purl 1 round, knit 1 round] twice.

Change to C1 and C3 and begin working from Snowman Chart. 16 sts of chart will be repeated twice around. Work even until Rnd 37 of Snowman Chart has been completed. Fasten off C1 and C3. Removing beg-of-rnd marker, reposition stitches so that 8 sts on each side of marker are on back needle and the remaining 16 sts are on front needle.

Note: You will be working back and forth over Heel Flap with C2.

Shape Heel Flap: Row 1 (RS): Join C2 to first stitch on back needle. Using back needle, with C2, sl 1 wyib, k15, turn, leaving 16 sts on front needle unworked.

Row 2 (WS): Sl 1 wyif, p15, turn. Rep the last 2 rows 4 times more (10 rows total), end on WS.

Turn Heel: Short Rows: Row 1 (RS): Sl 1 wyib, k8, k2tog, k1, turn—15 sts.

Row 2 (WS): Sl 1 wyif, p3, p2tog, p1, turn—14 sts.

Row 3 (RS): Sl 1 wyib, k4, k2tog, k1, turn—13 sts.

Row 4 (WS): Sl 1 wyif, p5, p2tog, p1, turn—12 sts.

Row 5 (RS): Sl 1 wyib, k6, k2tog, k1, turn—11 sts.

Row 6 (WS): Sl 1 wyif, p7, p2tog, p1, turn—10 sts. Break off yarn.

Gusset: With RS facing, join C1 in beginning of the first row of heel flap, with back needle, pick up and knit 7 sts along right side edge of heel flap, k10 sts

from back needle, pick up and knit 7 sts along left side edge of heel flap; with front needle, using C1, k16, place marker for new beginning of round—40 sts.

Note: You will now be working in the round again using both needles and C1.

Knit 1 round.

Dec Rnd: With back needle, k1, SSK, knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1; with front needle, k16—38 sts (2 sts dec'd on back needle). Knit 1 round. Rep the last 2 rounds 3 times more—32 sts (16 sts on each needle).

Foot: Knit 9 rounds even. Join C3 and work Rnds 1–3 of Snowman Chart. Fasten off C1 and C3.

Shape Toe: Join C2 and knit 1 round.

Dec Rnd: With C2, [k1, SSK, knit to the last 3 sts on needle, k2tog, k1] twice—4 sts dec'd (2 sts on each needle). Rep the last 2 rounds 4 times more—12 sts (6 sts on each needle). Break off yarn, leaving an 18" long end. Thread end into tapestry needle and weave stitches together using Kitchener Stitch.

FINISHING

Sew buttons for eyes, nose and body where indicated on Snowman Chart. Using black worsted-weight yarn, embroider mouth and twig arms where indicated in back stitch.

Hanging Loop: With crochet hook, join C2 at beginning of first round at top of stocking. Make a chain 3" long (or desired length), join with a slip stitch to top of stocking. Fasten off. Weave in all ends. With C3, make a 2½" pom-pom and sew to top of hat under hanging loop.

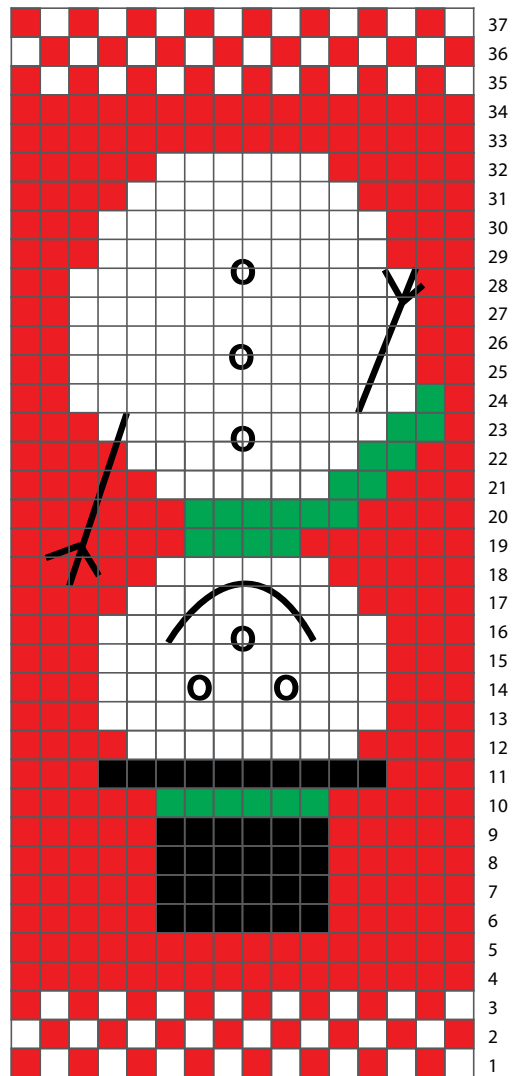

 Embroider twig arms and mouth in back stitch using black worsted-weight yarn.

STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

beg: beginning
CC: contrasting color
CDD: Centered Double Decrease—Slip 2 together (as if to k2tog), knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over
cn: cable needle
dec: decrease
dpn(s): double pointed needle(s)
end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side row.
end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side row
Garter St: Knit EVERY row when working back and forth in rows. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working in the round.
inc: increase
k: knit
k tbl: knit through the back loop(s)
k2tog: knit 2 stitches together
k3tog: knit 3 stitches together
kfb: knit in the front and back of the next st
LH: left hand
LLI: Left Lifted Increase—Insert LH needle into the purl bump one row below the st just worked on the RH needle and knit into this st (1 st inc'd)
M1: Make 1—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).
M1L: Make 1 Left—Work as for M1.
M1p: Make 1 purl—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).
M1pL: Make 1 purl Left—Work as for M1p.
M1pR: Make 1 purl Right—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).
M1R: Make 1 Right—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).
MC: main color
p: purl
p tbl: purl through the back loop(s)
p2tog: purl 2 stitches together

p3tog: purl 3 stitches together
pat(s): pattern(s)
pm: place marker
pss: pass slipped stitch over knit stitch
rep: repeat
Rev St st: Reverse Stockinette Stitch—Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round.
RH: right hand
RLI: Right Lifted Increase—Insert RH needle into the purl bump of the next st on the LH needle and knit into this st (1 st inc'd)
rnd(s): round(s)
RS: right side
sl: slip
sm: slip marker
SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.
SSP: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.
SSSK: Slip 3 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 3 stitches and knit 3 together.
st(s): stitch(es)
St st: Stockinette Stitch—Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round.
tbl: through back loop(s)
w&t: wrap and turn, a method of concealing a hole created in short row shaping. *On RS rows:* With yarn held in front, slip next stitch purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the back. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle. Turn your work. *On WS Rows:* With yarn held in back, slip next stitch purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the front. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle. Turn your work. Unless otherwise indicated, each time you come to a wrapped stitch when working subsequent rows, slip the wrap back over stitch and onto needle, then work the wrap together with its accompanying stitch.
WS: wrong side
wyib: with yarn in back
wyif: with yarn in front
yo: yarn over
