skill level: Easy

One size

finished measurements

Approximately 4" around x 3" high
(not including hanging cord)

yarn

BERROCO ULTRA WOOL (100 grs):

1 ball #33145 Sour Cherry (MC)

BERROCO PLUSH (50 grs): 1 ball

#1901 Cream (CC)

needles and notions

Knit version: 1 set (4) double pointed needles (dpns), size 7 (4.50 mm) or size to obtain gauge

Crocheted version: Crochet hook, size 4.50 mm (G) or size to obtain gauge

Both versions: Tapestry needle

gauge

Knit version: 20 sts and 27 rnds = 4" in St st with MC

Crocheted version: 15 sc and 20 rows = 4" in sc with MC

KNIT SANTA HAT

With CC, cast on 18 sts. Divide sts onto 3 needles (6 sts on each needle), place marker and join for working in the round.

Knit 3 rounds. Break off CC. Join MC and knit 4 rounds.

Dec Rnd 1: [K4, k2tog] 3 times – 15 sts. Knit 2 rounds.

Dec Rnd 2: [K3, k2tog] 3 times – 12 sts. Knit 2 rounds.

Dec Rnd 3: [K2, k2tog] 3 times – 9 sts. Knit 2 rounds.

Dec Rnd 4: [K1, k2tog] 3 times – 6 sts. Knit 1 rnd. Break off MC and change to CC.

Next Rnd: [K2tog] 3 times – 3 sts. Slip all 3 sts onto 1 dpn. Knit 1 row. Break off yarn, leaving a 6" long tail. Thread tail into tapestry needle and draw through all st on needle. Pull up tightly and fasten off.

FINISHING

Hanging Cord: Cut 1 strand of MC approximately 7" long. Using tapestry needle, draw both ends of strand through top of hat to wrong side on either side of faux pompom and tie tightly on inside. Weave in all ends.



ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

CC: contrasting color

dec: decrease

dpn(s): double pointed needle(s)

k: knit

k2tog: knit 2 stitches together

MC: main color

rnd(s): round(s)

st(s): stitch(es)

CROCHETED SANTA HAT

Special Abbreviations

Dec: Draw up a loop in each of the next 2 sc, yo and draw through all loops on hook – 1 sc dec'd.

HAT

With CC, ch 16. Being careful not to twist chain, join with a sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, join with a sl st in beg ch-1 – 15 sc.

Rep this round twice more. Change to MC and rep Rnd 1 three times more.

Dec Rnd 1: Ch 1, sc in each of the next 5 sc, dec over the next 2 sc, sc in each of the next 6 sc, dec over the last 2 sc, join with a sl st in beg ch-1 – 13 sc. Work even in sc for 3 rnds.

Dec Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in each of the next 4 sc, dec over the next 2 sc, sc in each of the next 5 sc, dec over the last 2 sc, join with a sl st in beg ch-1 – 11 sc. Work even in sc for 3 rnds.

Dec Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in each of the next 3 sc, dec over the next 2 sc, sc in each of the next 4 sc, dec over the last 2 sc, join with a sl st in beg ch-1 – 9 sc. Work even in sc for 2 rnds. Break off yarn leaving an 8" long tail. Thread tail into tapestry needle and draw through all sts. Pull up tightly and fasten off.

FINISHING

Pompom: Join CC with a sl st in top of hat. Ch 1, work 3 sc in top of hat, join with a sl st in beg ch-1. Work 1 rnd sc. Fasten off, leaving an end. Pull top of pompom together and secure.

Hanging Cord: Cut a 7" long strand of MC. Thread ends of strand through top of hat just below CC at top about ½" apart. Tie ends together on wrong side, leaving loop on outside for hanging. Weave in all ends.
